#### *Intent is to outline:*

- The third year- on-campus residency requirement
- The timeline and process for applying for on-campus housing.

### 3 Year Live-On Requirement

- Effective in the Fall 2025-Spring 2026 Academic Year
- Applies to students entering their third academic year.
  - Does not apply to transfer or exchange students.
- Exemption Criteria
  - Living with parents in permanent residents less than 50 miles from campus
  - 22 years of age before the first day of classes
  - Legally married
  - Legal guardian of a minor
  - Students studying abroad in the Fall of their Junior Year



## 2025-26 On-Campus Housing Application & Selection Timeline and Process

- January 28, 2025 Fall '25-Spring '26 academic year housing application opens
- February 25, 2025 Fall '25-Spring '26 academic year housing application closes
  - This is technically a preferred deadline, but the application remains open all the time.
- March 4, 2025 Roommate matching begins
- March 18, 2025 Rising 4<sup>th</sup> year students select housing
- March 19 & 20, 2025 Rising 3<sup>rd</sup> year students select housing
- March 25 27, 2025 Rising 2<sup>nd</sup> year students select housing
- November 1 Spring only housing application opens (always Nov. 1 every year, regardless of the day of the week)
- November 15 Spring only housing application closes (always Nov. 15 every year, regardless of the day of the week)

# Safety & Security -Tulane University Police Department Resources

The Tulane University Police Department (TUPD) is a full-service law enforcement agency that provides police services to the uptown and downtown campuses. TUPD strives to adhere to the best practices, including nationally recognized standards for the delivery of police services, and is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA).

TUPD officers work collaboratively with the New Orleans Police Department and are commissioned and vested with full powers of arrest at all Tulane University properties and within a one-mile perimeter area surrounding the uptown campus. The downtown campus patrols cover an area bounded by S. Claiborne Avenue to Loyola Avenue and Poydras Street to Canal Street. There are also several Tulane University properties outside of this boundary that are checked daily. TUPD officers patrol our campuses and the surrounding communities 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

# Safety & Security — Street Safety

- TUPD Escorts are available to all Tulane affiliates 24 hours a day, seven days a week. To request a TUPD escort, call: 504-865-5381
- Tulane TransLoc provides on-demand transportation service for Tulane community members. Uptown service is available from 6 p.m. to 3 a.m. Monday— Sunday. Service must be requested through the TransLoc app. (See <a href="https://shuttles.tulane.edu/tulane-transloc">https://shuttles.tulane.edu/tulane-transloc</a>.)

# Protecting Your Student's Belongings

- Tulane University strongly recommends all renters purchase some form of renters insurance. Renters insurance can protect their personal property in the event of theft or damage.
- A landlord's insurance policy does not cover any of the tenant's personal belongings.
- If appropriate, find out whether your student is covered under your insurance policy. Students are typically covered under their parents' policies when living on campus but are not typically covered when renting a privately owned property off campus.
- Homeowners insurance policies typically have larger deductibles (\$2,500-\$10,000) which may not provide coverage for smaller losses, whereas renters insurance policies can provide lower deductibles (\$250-\$500).
- Tulane University provides several resources for students to purchase a renters insurance policy directly from insurers to cover damage or theft of personal laptops, smartphones, clothes, books, bicycles, and more. Visit tulane.it/renters-insurance for details.
