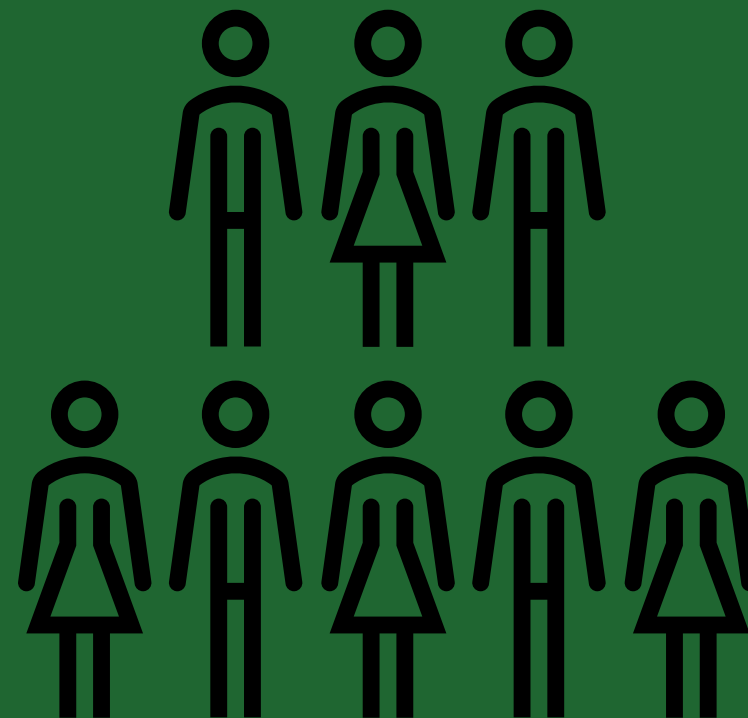

- Major, minor, interdisciplinary and specialized study options and exploration
- Navigating changes between majors or schools
- Understand university policies and procedures
- Transfer credit review and approval assistance
- Withdrawal and leave of absence
- Pre-professional planning and preparation

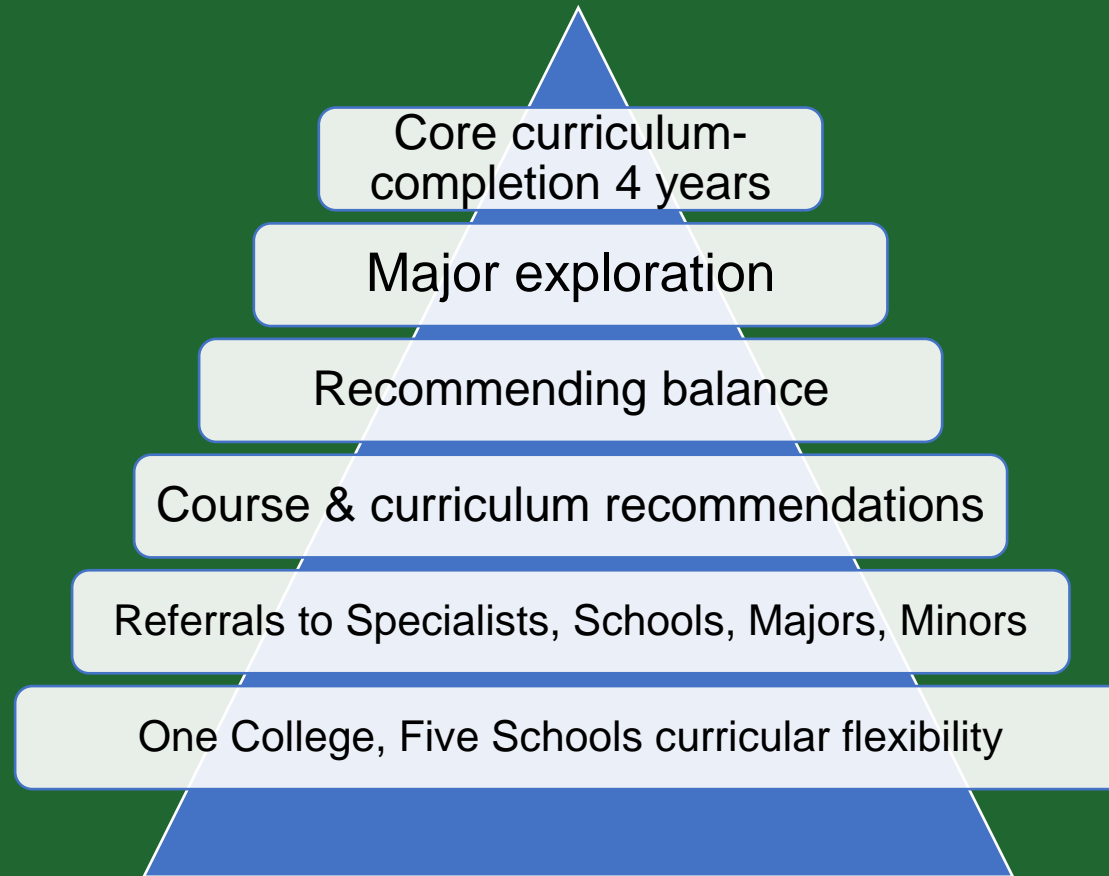

We encourage flexibility & the creation of multiple planners.



- Most Curricula at Tulane are flexible and there is time to adjust before the start of the semester.
- Remember, there are two months before the Spring Semester begins!
- Your student might make adjustments during the first two weeks of the semester.

Planning ahead

Certain majors at Tulane have 4-year plans available, such as Architecture and Engineering.

However —

Most majors are very flexible, and students typically develop a draft of a full four-year academic plan in collaboration with the academic & major advisors by the end of their fourth semester. Many majors contain multiple courses that satisfy requirements, so students are able to craft unique course sequences based on their interests. Students can add majors and minors through the beginning of the senior year.

How can you support your students



- Help your student reflect on what classes they will enjoy and what they will excel in.
- Have conversations with your student about academic plans that may require additional time or expense. (e.g. summer school ideas, study abroad, etc.)
- Refer them to the Advising website to schedule an appointment (advising.tulane.edu/connect)
- Refer them to Advisor of the Day or Walk-In Advising for urgent and quick questions.
- Remind your students to be patient and flexible. Help your student manage their expectations and encourage them to seek help from advisors when they feel stuck
